ENNS BIKE PATH

From Radstadt along the Enns to the Danube

The historical city of Radstadt is situated on the sun terrace of the Enns valley and charms with its tradition, nature, culture and diverse celebrations. The city's sights include the late gothic parish church, the gothic light column, the well preserved city walls, the museum of local history and recently a curious and world record pregnant „bikegarden“.

The most recent of Austria's great riverside bike paths is considered one of the most scenic local bicycle trails.

Many activities are waiting for you, for instance, on the well kept hiking trails and bridal paths, the outdoor swimming pool and a 18-hole golf course. Numerous places of interest can be conveniently reached from Radstadt, including the local Rossbrand mountain with its panoramic view on more than 150 alpine peaks, the Eisriesenwelt ice caves, the city of Salzburg and Austria's highest mountain, the Großglockner.

As an insider's tip for all nature lovers, the route leads through the three federal states of Salzburg, Styria and Upper Austria. Impressive mountains, romantic valleys, rushing wild streams, idyllic villages and historic towns accompany you through a unique landscape. The hilly nature of the tour ensures a challenge for all cyclists.

Radstadt certainly does its name credit (Radstadt = bicycle city). In the past years, Salzburg's Enns valley has become a paradise for cyclists. In addition to the Amadé-Bike-Marathon, the installation of the exclusive Austrian Stoneman „Taurista“ has recently become a top offer for mountain bikers with 123 km and 4,500 vertical meters. But also for families and e-bikers numerous attractive routes are offered.

The path begins at 1,000 meters above sea level, at the foot of the Niedere Tauern mountains. The first stage is dominated by impressive mountain scenery, idyllic swimming lakes and the yet tranquil flow of the Enns river. The contrast between the rough light-colored Dachstein massive to the left and the dark crystalline rocks of the Niederen Tauern to the right is especially captivating – as the narrow trail widens.

Due to its central location and transport links (express train and bus station), the tranquil town is of course also the ideal starting point for the Enns cycle path.

Past the majestic Grimming mountain and castle of Trautenfels, the path leads to the Benedictine abbey of Admont with its famous abbey library at the entrance to the Gesäuse – the most spectacular stretch of the Enns, where the river thunders its way through the Gesäuse National Park. There are two wildly romantic alternative routes away from the busy regional road, the Rauchboden and Ennsbodenweg.

Between the old trading town of Steyr and Enns, Austria's oldest city, the wide and slow flowing river marks the border between Upper and Lower Austria. Here you can conveniently access the Danube-, Roman- and Steyrtal bike path.

Route:
From Flachauwinkl in Salzburg's Pongau region to Enns, near the confluence with the Danube in Upper Austria.

Length:
Between 240 and 280 kilometers, depending on the chosen route, with an elevation difference of 900 meters.

Level of difficulty:
Easy to moderate

Path:
Well paved bike trails and back roads with low traffic. In Styria there are sections of more frequented roads with scenic alternate routes.

Ideal time for cycling:
Middle of May to middle of October

Recommended schedule:
Theoretically 2-3 days, though it is advisable to take about a week to enjoy the many sights and wonders of nature.

The right bicycle:
Light touring or trekking bike and also e-bike.

Traveling with children:
It is advisable to take this trip with children only after they have obtained their bicycle permit and have sufficient experience with riding on public roads.

Arrival in and return journey to Radstadt:
By train to Radstadt (express station). There are several daily train connections between Radstadt and the Danube. Bike transport is possible on most trains, but there is a reservation requirement. From Enns to Radstadt, there are several connections, each with 2 x change and a journey time of about 3 3/4 hours. A bit better (only 1-2 x change) and faster (driving time about 3 1/2 hours) are some connections from St. Valentin (about 8 km from Enns - taxi transfer see below) to Radstadt. From Enns to St. Valentin (station) including bike and luggage transfer: approx. € 25 for up to 8 persons. Tel. +43 7435 59000 (www.taxi-59000.at) or +43 664 8214327


Bus transfer from Enns to Radstadt:

Signposting:
The signposting for the Ennsbike path is different in each state. In Salzburg one follows the square to portrait format green signs with the label "Ennsradweg". In Styria small green signs marked "R7" show the way and in Upper Austria the longish green markers again have the inscription "Ennsradweg".



ROUTE



6-day-tour

1. day: Individual arrival

Individual arrival and overnight stay in Radstadt, the historical city in the Salzburger Sportwelt region. Overnight stay in Radstadt at the Hotel-Gasthof Brüggler. **Tip in the case of an earlier arrival:** Entry tour to the starting point of the Enns bike path (approx. 40 km round trip). From Radstadt a slight ascent leads through Flachau to Flachauwinkl, where the Enns bike path begins at the confluence of the Enns and the PleiBling rivers.

2. day: Radstadt – Aigen im Ennstal (approx. 66 km)

Heading downstream from Radstadt over the state line at Mandling and past the town of Schladming to Trautenfels (castle), the path continues past Irdning to Aigen on the Putterersee lake. Overnight stay in Aigen at the Landhotel – Gut Puttererseehof.

3. day: Aigen im Ennstal – St. Gallen (approx. 71 km)

From Aigen through the shopping city of Liezen to Admont (world's largest abbey library!). Further along the Enns river through the picturesque „Gesäuse“, where the Enns abruptly descends almost 130 meters, through Hief্লাu, Großreifling (forestry museum) to St. Gallen (Gallenstein castle). For the section between Admont and St. Gallen the company Taxi- und Busreisen Weissensteiner also offers a transfer service including bicycle and luggage transport (telephone reservation +43 664 4329926). Overnight stay in St. Gallen at the Naturhotel Schloss Kassegg

4. day: St. Gallen – Reichraming (approx. 47 km)

From St. Gallen to Altenmarkt (state line to upper Austria) and onward along the Enns past Weyer (beautiful market, Enns museum) to Reichraming. The wonderful alternate route (is the heart of the Enns bike trail) leads through the Reichraminger Hintergebirge in the Kalkalpen National Park. From the hotel

you drive via St. Gallen to just before Altenmarkt. Then it goes to the left towards Unterlaussa 8 km slightly ascending and then 3.5 km relatively steep uphill to the „Mooshöhe“. For the section between Admont and St. Gallen the company Taxi- und Busreisen Weissensteiner also offers a transfer service including bicycle and luggage transport (telephone reservation +43 664 4329926). From there it's downhill through 13 tunnels all the way to Reichraming. Overnight stay in Reichraming at the Gasthof Ortbauerngut.

5. day: Reichraming – Enns (approx. 57 km)

The cycle path leads from Reichraming (brass museum) via Losenstein (ruin), Trattenbach (floating alpine hut), Garsten (collegiate church, nail smithy) and the medieval baroque and shopping town of Steyr (landmark „Bummerlhaus“) to Enns, the oldest town in Austria with its impressive city tower and the roman museum Lauriacum.

Overnight stay in Enns at the Gathof-Hotel Zum Goldenen Schiff.

6. day: Individual return trip

Tip:

Additional day on the Danube Bike Path
From Enns to the Danube bike ferry to Mauthausen (concentration camp memorial). From there along the north-facing Danube Bike Path to the Danube power station Wallsee-Mitterkirchen bridge (bike station). Return on the south-facing Danube Bike Path via St. Pantaleon, Pyburg and Ennsdorf to Enns.
Length of the route: 52 km, altitude difference: 80 m
Overnight stay in Enns at the Gathof-Hotel Zum Goldenen Schiff (extra charge).



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BOOKING INFORMATION



Important information:

- * Only applies when booking the "inn-category". At full occupancy, accommodation will be in an equivalent house within a radius of 10 km.
- ** Luggage transport at least 2 persons. When the luggage transport is used it's mandatory for all tour participants. Only 1 piece of luggage per person. Free luggage transport from the Gathof-Hotel Zum Goldenen Schiff to the station in Enns.
- *** Prices without local tax, payable on site at the individual accommodations.

The Enns cycle path package tour is not suitable for people with reduced mobility.

Prices:

The prices shown are per person. The prices include VAT and is exclusive local tax, which is payable on site at the individual accommodations.

Child discount:

Children up to 15 years get a 20% discount when booking the same room as parents. Luggage transfer: € 40,- per child

Booking/payment:

The offer can only be booked via the Radstadt Tourist Association specifying the desired accommodation category. After booking, you will immediately receive a confirmation with a request for an advance payment amounting to 20 % of the price. The deposit occurs no earlier than eleven months before the agreed end of the trip and amounts to 20% of the tour price or, within the 11 months, immediately after receiving the booking confirmation. Upon transferring your payment to our bank account, you accept the terms and conditions (https://www.wko.at/branchen/tourismus-freizeitwirtschaft/hotellerie/AGBH_englisch.pdf). Upon receipt of the deposit the booking is binding. The balance must be paid no earlier than 20 days prior to departure. Additional down payments and final payment may not be demanded and are not secured. Guarantor or insurer is the HDI Global SE Versicherung in Hannover.

Travel documents:

Will be sent to you by post before arrival. For short-term bookings, the documents are deposited at your accommodation.

Passport and visa requirements:

Identity card suffices, no visa, no vaccinations.

Liability and limitation of liability:

Participation in this tour is at your own risk. Minors may only participate in the tour when accompanied by a parent or guardian. Each participant is responsible that they are healthy enough for the trip. Compliance with the Road Traffic Act also is the responsibility of the participant.

Travel agency insurance regulations (RSV):

All travelers who are on trips organised by us are insured with the HDI Global SE Versicherung in Hannover. This applies for payments that have already been made, if the travel service is not provided in full or in part due to the insolvency of the organiser. As per §7 para. 1/24 RSV we hereby announce that we do not require down payments exceeding 20% of the tour price up to two weeks before the start of the trip. The liability of the HDI Global SE Versicherung to the customer is limited to the price the customer has paid for the trip and, in case of damages, it is limited to the total insured sum. If the insured sum for settling all claims is not sufficient, the demands of the customers are satisfied with the partial amount.
